Dear Parent/Guardian:

On April 26, 27 and 28 all **freshmen (Grade 9)** students in Edison and JP Stevens High Schools will take the ELA and Math New Jersey Student Learning Assessment (NJSLA). All freshmen will take their normal bus and will arrive by the 7:35 Warning Bell.

On April 26 and 27, all **junior (Grade 11)** students in Edison and JP Stevens High Schools will take the Science New Jersey Student Learning Assessment (NJSLA- S). On April 26 and 27, all juniors will take their normal bus and will arrive by the 7:35 Warning Bell. Juniors are testing only two days; therefore, they will have late arrival on April 28 and report to school by 10:30 a.m. A second bus run will be provided for late arrival.

Senior (Grade 12) and sophomore (Grade 10) students will be expected to report to school by 10:30 a.m. A second bus run will be provided for late arrival. Students taking this bus should be at their normal bus stop three hours later than their usual time. Students will attend classes on an abbreviated schedule at the conclusion of testing.
