VI. COMMITTEE REPORTS

1. Finance & Facilities Committee

The Finance and Facilities Committee met on June 10, 2021 at 4:00 p.m. at the Education Center.

Mohin Patel, Jingwei "Jerry" Shi, Elizabeth Conway, Bernard F. Bragen, Jr., Ed.D., Edward Aldarelli, Ed.D. and William Kolibas

Items Discussed:

- The Committee discussed the possibility of adding a second level on the John P. Stevens High School Auditorium. Architects from DMR Architects will explore those options.
- Pete Campisano from USA Architects reviewed the H VAC renovation costs at both high schools for auditorium and cafeterias for about \$850,000 for each of the four areas.
- The Committee approved the HVAC renovations in all areas and a full renovation of the Edison High School auditorium for a total of \$4.5 million (the HVAC costs will be fully funded from ESSER II funds). Edison will pause on the full renovation at the John P. Stevens High School auditorium and explore other options, such as the creation of a Performing Arts Center on the campus. The Committee asked DMR Architects to come up with some ideas for further review.
- The Lincoln Elementary School addition is still on time and Edison is currently waiting on approval from the Board Attorney review of the bid winner to award the construction contract.
- Representatives from DMR Architects presented on conducting an Energy Savings Improvement Plan (ESIP) using a company called DCO. This savings could possibly generate a net of approximately \$10 million in capital improvements for energy-based projects.
- DMR Architects also shared proposed costs for three different Career Academy Schools options on the Talmadge and Coolidge properties for 500, 768 and 1,000 students each, with the respective cost being about \$43 million, \$60 million and \$87 million each. These costs do not include possible soft costs of 15-20%. Dr. Bragen is scheduled to meet with Rob DeLio, the property owner of the Talmadge and Coolidge sites to review the financing options and will report back to Finance and Facilities Committee with the options.

- Summer roofing projects were reviewed and the Committee agreed to go out for bid on the Edison High School (built up) and Washington Elementary School (spray-on) roofs. The Thomas Jefferson Middle School roof project was originally slated to be completed via the Co-op, but the Committee later decided that should be put out for bid as well.
- The John P. Stevens High School turf baseball field will cost about \$100,000 in engineering costs and the cost of the field will be \$1.5 million to \$2 million.
- The Wildan Company presented their possible program for an ESIP, with total savings numb3r s similar to those presented by DCO.
- The Committee agreed that they should seek other companies for ESIPs and attempt to secure the best deal.

2. Food Service Committee

The Food Service Committee met on June 9, 2021 at 4:00 p.m. at the Education Center.

In attendance were: Jingwei "Jerry" Shi, Biral Patel, Virginia White, Mohin Patel, Ann Kluck, Gregory Brennan, Patrick Kissane and Bernard F. Bragen, Jr., Ed.D.

Items Discussed:

- Three companies were selected from the RFPs to present food samples and their
 programs for the provision of food services to the Edison Township school district. The
 companies were Aramark, Maschio's and Pomptonian. All three companies offered a
 higher investment guarantee than the current food service provider and a wider variety of
 food options for students and staff.
- After a lengthy discussion and sampling of a portion of the provided food samples, the remaining Board of Education committee members (Virginia White, Mohin Patel and Jingwei "Jerry" Shi) selected Maschio's to present to the full Board of Education for approval at the June 29, 2021 public meeting.

3. Special Education Committee

The Special Education Committee met on June 18, 2021 at 10:00 a.m. at the Education Center.

In attendance were: Christopher Conklin, Ed.D., Dawn Netzel, Allison Hines, Erin Madera, Nancy Sica, Carol Bodofsky, Biral Patel, Shivi Madhukar and Elizabeth Conway

Items Discussed:

- ESY 7/6/21-8/18/21 to be held at ten of the school buildings with 106 staff members. There will be a total of 30 days of learning. 506 students were recommended for the program and 374 will be attending.
- Five Child Study Teams will be in working on IEPs during the summer and maybe extra, depending on the need.
- Staffing will be moved around to fulfill all needs at the various schools.
- Nursing staffing is still an ongoing difficulty, but trying to fill positions.
- United Therapy Solutions has been a big help filling positions, especially for Occupational Therapy.
- Enrollment projections may change with the pandemic lessoning.

- Law 3434 is only to see if students still need services that were not provided in their IEPs. If out of district schools didn't provided any services, Edison will follow up on this matter. There is a memo summarizing the press release on The Office of Special Educations Services.
- There is continued professional development for the Crisis Prevention Institute (In House).
- Paraprofessionals will get Registered Behavior Therapist training.
- The meeting ended at 10:40 a.m.

4. <u>Township Liaison Committee</u>

The Township Liaison Committee met at 11:00 A.M. on June 15, 2021 in the Education Center.

In attendance were: Mohin Patel, Shivi Madhukar, Biral Patel, Virginia White, Bernard F. Bragen, Ed.D., and Council Members: Sam Joshi and Joyce Ship-Freeman, and via Zoom, Mayor Tomas Lankey, Deputy Fire Chief/OEM Coordinator Andrew Toth, and Township Business Administrator Maureen Ruan

Items Discussed:

- Edison Art Society: Gloria Dittman provided the committee with an update. The Edison Art Society is in need of buildings to place murals outside. They would like to have buildings in all parts of town, ie: Piscatawaytown, Clara Barton, Menlo, Oak Tree. Mrs. Dittman has the artists but she needs locations. She can be reached via email gsdittman@optimum.net or phone 732-887-5733. In addition, she stated that the Gazebo in Papianni Park is moving forward nicely and will be completed by the end of July or early August.
- Properties: Mayor Lankey provided an update on the Stelton School and Kilmer properties. The Mayor is supportive in the committee's quest to obtain the properties for the district. The township attorney is in the process of writing up the options that the district has for the locations for schools. The Mayor stated that he supports school usage for both locations. The update will also include options on the house that is on the property between Stelton School and Thomas Jefferson Middle School. The question of potential contamination came up for the Kilmer properties. There is a contamination study, as well as an environmental study. Mayor Lankey and Dr. Bragen will look into both of these studies. Mrs. White thanked Mayor Lankey for his support relating to the Silverlake warehouse issues.
- COVID-19 Update Deputy Chief Toth provided the committee with a COVID-19 update.
 He indicated that Pfizer is the vaccine approved for people as young as 12 years of age. Lester
 Jones from the County Department of Health is trying to secure vaccines for school age
 children. Dr. Bragen shared the results of the COVID-19 Vaccine Survey and reported that
 the district is offering COVID-19 vaccines in the schools for students who wish to be
 vaccinated. So far over 1,000 students were interested.
- Topics Discussed: Councilwoman Ship-Freeman reviewed notes from a meeting with Deputy Fire Chief Toth, Fire Captains Joe Anselmo and Rob Niscoia and Dr. Bragen on promoting women in male dominated fields: ie: Firefighting. Deputy Fire Chief Toth is creating a presentation for high school seniors this fall on careers in the Edison Fire Department. In addition, Ms. Ship-Freeman spoke of the program Mallory's Army. Other Board of Education members expressed concerns about placing emotional support in place for the students when they return to school in September 2021. Dr. Bragen informed the committee that plans are in place for these additional supports.
- Councilman Joshi asked the Board of Education to get the word out on Edison Youth Services. They would like to get 75 students from each high school to participate. He also asked for a list of shared services between the township and the school district.

• Mr. Biral Patel inquired about the shared services with police for security. Dr. Bragen stated that security was in place before he arrived in Edison as Superintendent. He proposed that Patrick Kissane, Director of Safety and Security, is invited to attend the next meeting.

- Council members Ship-Freeman and Joshi expressed concerns over the school crossing guards. When a crossing guard is out, their post has to be covered by a police officer. There is a shortage of guards and this is a safety concern for the children. School crossing guards are employed by the township. The committee was informed that this shortage in personnel was because the township no longer provides medical benefits to this group of employees. Dr. Bragen inquired about reinstating their benefits. These posts must be covered. Mr. Mohin Patel suggested using auxiliary police to help out the crossing guards and police in this situation.
- Tennis Courts A discussion took place regarding improvements to the tennis courts on the Board of Education property. Dr. Bragen discussed this with the Finance and Facilities Committee. This issue relates to funding for these capital projects.
- The next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, July 20, 2021 at 11:00 a.m. at the Education Center.
