VI. <u>COMMITTEES</u>

1. <u>Curriculum & Technology Committee</u>

Mrs. Madhukar reported that the Curriculum and Technology Committee met at 2:00 P.M. on November 12, 2020 remotely through ZOOM.

In attendance were: Shivi Madhukar, Carol Bodofsky, Elizabeth Conway, Dr. Yunxia Chen, Gail Pawlikowski and Baninder Mahabir

Items Discussed:

- Middle School Survey: The Committee discussed a survey that was administered to all middle school students to understand issues they may be facing. The Committee requested that a similar survey should be administered to high school students.
- Grade 10 PSAT: It will be administered in February 2021. Information for signup, including requirements for transportation, should be going out soon.
- Gifted & Talented: Students currently have been temporarily moved to a model of independent project with consultation time. They should be going back to the traditional model soon.
- Technology Chromebooks have not been delivered yet. They should be delivered any day now.
- The Committee was also informed about changes to curriculum guides. The AP Biology and AP Chemistry course structure were tweaked to meet the changes in the AP test, and the Forensics curriculum was tweaked to meet the new science standards.
- Other items:
 - Small Groups Going well in elementary schools.
 - Importance of posting grades on parent portal in a timely manner for effective feedback before next quiz or test.
 - Need for uniformity or standardization in testing rigor and grading practices, as well as time given to complete work for effective placement decisions.
 - No decisions made on placement.

The meeting adjourned at 2:30 P.M.

2. Finance & Facilities Committee

Mrs. Conway reported that the Finance and Facilities Committee met at 4:00 P.M. on November 10, 2020 in the Education Center.

In attendance were: Elizabeth Conway, Ralph Errico, dr. Yunxia Chen, Shivi Madhukar, Bernard F. Bragen, Jr., Ed.D., Daniel P. Michaud, Edward Aldarelli, Ed.D., and Will Kolibas

Items Discussed:

- Mr. Kolibas reviewed the maintenance projects that are in progress or have been completed during 2020-2021 which include projects such as: Woodrow Wilson Middle School water main diversion project and the concrete planters for the modular classrooms as protection against vehicular traffic, roofing projects, numerous paving improvement projects, locker replacements at John P. Stevens high School and Woodrow Wilson Middle School, boiler replacement at Lincoln School and a fence replacement at Edison High School. The Committee discussed with Mr. Kolibas, maintenance schedules for each school and a sign-off sheet for the staff. Mr. Kolibas had already prepared the schedules and sign-off sheets and emailed them to the committee members.
- The Committee discussed the building use application and recommended that the policy and regulations be modified to include required security guards and to revise the discount for users of ten or more scheduled sessions to 50% of the building use fees. There will be no discount for custodial or security charges.
- The Committee discussed the available property across from Menlo Park School that is currently available. Dr. Bragen will inquire about the cost of the property and try to determine if the acquisition of the property would benefit the district. He will report back at a future committee meeting.
- Dr. Aldarelli discussed the new Educators Heath Plan that all new staff members hired on or after 7/1/20 have to enroll in and remain for 7 years. Any staff members who were hired prior to 7/1/20 have the option of enrolling in the Educators Plan or remain in their current plan. The administration, at a recent meeting, directed Alamo Insurance Brokers to investigate all options for the 2021-2022 school year, including self-insurance, implementing the difference card, minimum premium and seeking competitive quotes from other carriers.
- Dr. Bragen notified the Committee that he had requested that our Architect of Record, USA Architects, prepare an ESIP (Energy Savings) proposal in which the district could make energy savings improvements that would be paid for from energy savings over a 15 to 20 year period.
- Dr. Bragen discussed a proposal in which an outside firm would review and assess the District's back to school plan and make recommendations for improvements, if needed.
- Dr. Chen questioned whether the district had any plans to use the COVID vaccine.

The meeting adjourned at 5:24 P.M.

3. Food Service Committee

Mr. Shi reported that the Food Service Committee met at 4:30 P.M. on November 12, 2020 at the Education Center.

In attendance were: Board of Education: Jingwei (Jerry) Shi, Shannon Peng, Bernard F. Bragen, Ed.D., Daniel P. Michaud and Chartwells Representatives: Gene Sanchez (Regional Vice president), Patricia Allegretto (District Manager) and Lisa Taddei (Director of Dining Services)

Items Discussed:

- The Committee discussed the number of lunches being serviced daily since the district's hybrid educational program has begun and the average ranges between 1,800 and 2,000 per day.
- The Committee discussed the possibility of providing breakfast and lunch for multiple days that can be taken home by the students or picked up by their parents and also serving meals for the weekends.

Chartwells will begin providing multiple meal packs in early December. They will provide three, five or seven breakfasts and lunches for the students that can be picked up or brought home. The number of meals that they will receive depends on what day it is and whether the student is attending school or is receiving only remote instruction.

- The District is currently providing free breakfast and lunch to all students based on the federal "Seamless Summer Option" (SSO) which was ordered by the federal government due to the COVID-19 pandemic. It will continue through June 30, 2021. The District receives federal and stee reimbursement subsidies to cover the cost of these meals.
 - Chartwells explained that the federal government provides all schools free commodities to use to feed the students and the commodities can include items such as cheeses, meats and fresh fruits and vegetables.
 - After the Chartwells representatives left, the Committee directed the administration to prepare an RFP to seek a new food service contract for the 2021-2022 school year. They also directed the administration to omit the capital investment from the RFP.

The meeting adjourned at 5:55 P.M.

4. Special Education Committee

Mrs. Conway reported that the Special Education Committee met at 2:00 P.M. on November 23, 2020 remotely through ZOOM.

In attendance were: Elizabeth Conway, Falguni Patel, Carol Bodofsky, Bernard F. Bragen, Ed.D., Christopher Conklin, Ed.D., Dawn Netzel, Nancy Sica and Erin Madara

Items Discussed:

- Updates were given on programs, numbers of students and referrals. 46% of students are in school and 54% of students are at home.
- Updates were give on the resources being used.
- Updates were given on staffing, in house and related services.
- The only challenge is transportation, but that issue is being worked on.

The meeting adjourned at 2:40 P.M.
