#### I. CALL TO ORDER/FLAG SALUTE

The June 15, 2015 Public Meeting of the Edison Board of Education was called to order by Board President, Mrs. Veena Iyer, at 7:00 P.M. at Edison High School, 50 Boulevard of Eagles, Edison, NJ.

John Adams Middle School Student, Karan Menon, 2015 National Geographic Bee Champion, led the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### II. ROLL CALL

Also in attendance were Richard O'Malley, Ed.D, Superintendent, Mr. Daniel P. Michaud, Business Administrator/Board Secretary, and Mr. Jonathan Busch, Board Attorney.

#### III. OPENING STATEMENT

Mrs. Iyer read the following opening statement:

"The New Jersey Open Public Meetings Law was enacted to insure the right of the public to have advance notice of and to attend the meetings of public bodies at which any business affecting their interests is discussed or acted upon.

In accordance with the provisions of this act, the Edison Board of Education has caused notice of this meeting to be published by having the date, time and place thereof posted in the Board of Education Administrative Offices. Copies of these notices were sent to the Home News and Tribune and the Star Ledger on March 31, 2014.

The Public may participate at regular meetings in accordance with the By-Laws and the applicable State regulations.

#### IV. <u>STUDENT RECOGNITION</u> (Exhibit A)

Mr. Robert Pispecky, Supervisor of Music and Visual Arts, emceed the student recognition program honoring students for their outstanding efforts and accomplishments. The following resolution was presented to the board for approval:

#### V. EDISON HIGH SCHOOL PRESENATION – CHARLES ROSS, PRINCIPAL

Mr. Ross exclaimed that he could not believe another year has flown by. He welcomed all to Student Recognition night, a chance the Board has to publically fete the best and brightest students of Edison Township.

Mr. Ross continued by saying that he may be the "king of the catch phrase" but is pleased to see "What's Great About Edison" spreading out from the Boulevard to all of the Elementary Schools and their essay contest.

As for the Home of the Eagles, Mr. Ross stated that he is most proud of the sustained growth of Edison High School. Each year the students are prepared to thrive in their next world, be it the country's best universities or a career. Looking into the lobby, all can see some of the places the best and brightest students are going.

He would ask the seniors "Where are you going to be on June 17<sup>th</sup>?" But that is not enough. While public compulsory education ends after high school, the staff of Edison High School has made great strides in getting their "Eaglettes" ready for what comes after the RAC and Project Graduation. The facilities have expanded dramatically along with access to technology. The students mastered the HSPA, with the Class of 2015 meeting all goals in every subgroup. This demonstrates positive results in the District's push for educational equity between the Township high schools.

Edison High School enjoys the high bar that was set by John P. Stevens High School and Ms. Pawlikowski's students. This year, the students embraced the challenge of PARCC. With help from the Central Office and a focused staff, Edison High School had virtually no problems testing over 1,500 students online.

In over five years, Edison High School increased the number of AP tests taken by over 63-percent of the students; and the students reap the benefits of the collaborations with Middlesex County, Rutgers and other New Jersey schools. It is a regular occurrence to have parents come back and let us know how our alumni get out a semester early. This year, every member of the Junior Class, who has not yet demonstrated college readiness on the SAT, has already been administered a college placement test and has been given online tutoring to prepare them. The STEM and AVID programs have gained momentum. The business and technical programs are being expanded and structured to get students to be the bosses of the new and old economy, to tap that vein of entrepreneurial spirit that will grow our country over the next fifty years.

Mr. Ross continued by saying "you can't hide that eagle pride"...but that's not only about the Red and the Gold. It's not only about state champs, pep rallies, awarding winning bands and choirs, Mr. EHS, the Merck Science Test...It's deeper.

He told two stories that show the culture at Edison High School that is sustaining the school's growth. The first one is about a student...known as "the Maestro." Blocked by a condo association from practicing Chopin and Brahms in his home, he rode his bike over three miles each way to come to the High School this past summer, four to five days a week, to practice on the school's piano. The maestro was thrown an obstacle, but took responsibility for his success, didn't complain, and kept moving forward. He realized that greatness must be earned and trusted that Edison High School would support him in his efforts. Mr. Ross was proud to say that this student will be playing for the graduation and will be attending Rutgers University in the fall.

The next story is about a group of students..."the mover uppers." These young people heard the clarion call to work harder, to push themselves to the most rigorous possible curriculum and do what is necessary to move up to the honors and Advanced Placement levels. Starting as freshmen, they saw teachers, supervisors and the Principal, letting all know they were honors material. "Mr. Ross, may I have an appointment? I want to go into medicine and I need this class." "Mr. Ross, I want to be an engineer"...etc. etc. Mr. Ross responded "well, I'm from Missouri...show me...Are you willing to work?...Are you willing to struggle?...to fall short and get back up?" With guidance everyone worked with them, delineate the bar they need to reach, and the steps needed to get there. The mover uppers resolve to learn as much as they can from whatever source they can find. They work hard and add support to our belief that they can achieve more and succeed in higher level classes. Each spring, the mover uppers show everyone and place into those classes in greater numbers.

In conclusion, Mr. Ross thanked his staff, who, like so many of those in Edison, work way beyond the typical day to meet to meet the needs of the students. It is not unusual to see them at the high school by 6:00 A.M. and to have students knocking on the window to get in early for extra help.

The PTSO comes in before dawn three times a year for the honor roll breakfasts and for project graduation. He thanked the PTSO as well. He also thanked Ms. Sandra Schlatter, Edison High School Assistant Principal, who is leaving to serve as Principal of Washington Elementary School. Mr. Ross commended Ms. Schlatter, stating that not often in a career do you encounter an educator of such high caliber...someone who cares about people, yet gets them to grow as professionals. She is one who takes the mundane administrative duties and turns them into opportunities to increase school pride and build leadership in our young people, someone who learns and someone who has taught him, as well. Mr. Ross said that although Ms. Schlatter will be missed, he is glad that she is staying close by so that Edison High School can reap the benefits of her work at Washington Elementary School.

#### XI. COMMITTEES

#### 1. Finance & Facilities Committee

Dr. Heelan reported that the Finance and Facilities Committee met on June 9, 2015 at the Education Center.

In attendance were: Deborah A. Anes, Jerry Shi, Theresa E. Ward, Dr. Frank Heelan (Board Members), Dr. Richard O'Malley (Superintendent), Daniel P. Michaud (Business Administrator/Board Secretary), Kenneth Stromsland, (Director of Facilities), Ken Karle (LAN Associates – Architect) and School Alliance Insurance Fund Team, William Dittmann, Barbara Murphy, et al.

#### Discussion:

- Ms. Murphy (SAIF) proposed to provide the Edison School District with the same or better insurance coverage than the former School Boards Insurance, with a savings of over \$50,000 from the Budget. SAIF will cover the Edison School District alone with \$400,000,000 property limit; \$25,000,000 Ordinance and Law sublimit per incident; extra expense and business interruption coverage for \$25,000,000; liability limit for auto and general for \$20,000,000 and other appropriate insurance coverage for a total cost of \$2,211,365.
- Underground storage tanks from 1990 must be removed from Menlo Park Elementary School grounds and the 1993 storage tank DEP file from Woodbrook Elementary School will have to be closed out. Both air conditioning and sprinkler systems will be installed in both these additions.
- Mr. Karle has formed a good working relationship with Dobco Construction Company for the James Monroe Elementary School. During the current debris removal phase, new footings are being dug where needed, and the curbing and steps will be replaced.
- Mr. Stromsland reviewed major summer projects: (A) Bids were rejected as excessive for the Washington Elementary School multipurpose room, and an alternate method of providing the renovation is being investigated; (B) Nickerson Company will not deliver lockers for Woodrow Wilson and John Adams Middle Schools and John P. Stevens High School until mid-August; (C) the District has received a lower price from Vanguard to relocate the four trailer classrooms from New Brunswick to John P. Stevens High School (3) and FDR Building (1); and (D) the new ShopRite store, classroom and storage area will be constructed at Edison High School.
- Bids were received from five contractors for the roof renovations at Martin Luther King Elementary School and Thomas Jefferson Middle School. Roof Management was the lowest bidder for \$499,000; and it is recommended that Roof Management be awarded the bid.
- There is a new law for annual reporting to the Board of all expiring, renewing or awarding of contracts.
- Salaries of exempt employees were analyzed by the Finance & Facilities Committee and recommendations will be given to the full Board for approval.
