"projected" increase in salaries.

The topic of computer security was discussed. This included the discussion on the security of the computer units and peripheral devices. This topic will be readdressed with principals and their respective building procedures. Mr. Frisina will begin researching the cost of using a LOJACK type system on laptops to assist with unit security.

Mr. Benedict gave a Web Page update. We, as a committee, are in agreement that the website should remain as the main site. Principals must continue to provide Mr. Benedict with monthly information needed to keep it up-to-date. Additional school sites developed by

parents or PTOs should be carefully monitored by the principal.

Mr. Benedict discussed Genesis and the summer school program developed in the system. Mrs. Anes would like the technology department to possibly change the pressure seal paper due to clarity and position of grade information. Mr. Benedict and Mr. Frisina have been working on the problem and will resolve it by next year.
