Mrs. Anes reported that the Curriculum Committee met at 1:00 PM on June 8, 2010 at the Education Center.

In attendance were: Mrs. Deborah A. Anes, Mr. John Fenimore, Dr. Michael Quinn and Ms. Deborah Bredahl.

Items Discussed:

- Ms. Bredahl introduced Mr. Charles Ross, candidate for principal at Edison High School, who spoke about his experiences and ideas.
- Ms. Susan Cohen, Supervisor of Health Services, distributed and explained the Coordinated School Health Plan, which blends resources and personnel to promote the health and well being of the whole child. A grant is being prepared through the Monmouth County Board of Health for Central New Jersey, of which Edison is the Middlesex County representative. She explained the 2-Year Agreement between the District and Middlesex County College. Student nurses, as part of their community health program, are helping in our elementary and middle schools.
- Mr. Fenimore, Director of Curriculum, explained the 4th year no-cost extension for the Hindi FLAP Grant, for which the district had applied and received. In addition, he distributed a summary of the AP Initiative – Year Two. Revised curriculum guides for two Computer Science classes were presented and recommended for approval. Three out-of-state field trips and Smartboard training, using ARRA funds for twelve teachers, were also presented and recommended for approval.
- Ms. Bredahl, Coordinator of NCLB, shared the most current AHSA numbers, and shared the recent alternative measures for high school graduation requirements. She also reported on the most recent HSPA test results from the March testing. The floor slab was poured on 6/7/10, the steel stairs and landings are expected to be installed before the end of June along with the roof framing. Phase-1 work is one week behind schedule. Phase 2 – Work began 6/1/10, all interior demolition including the existing roofing removal was completed, 2nd floor layouts for walls, demo/layouts mechanical, plumbing and electrical work and installation of the new block fire-wall began. Steel framing was delivered and installation will begin immediately.
- Benjamin Franklin Elementary School Exterior Stairs and Ramp Repair – Proposals were submitted for replacing the broken concrete stairs, replace broken block, re-point and parge block and replace the cracked concrete at the top of the stair landing. Additional quotes to be submitted.
- HVAC Edison High School - Jersey State Controls has begun to do the demolition of the valves and controls in areas of the building that do not interfere with the students.
- Asthma Friendly Schools – On May 25, 2010 Mr. Jenney (Designated Person) and Diane Costello (District Nurse) attended training for Asthma Friendly Schools given by the Pediatric/Adult Asthma Coalition of New Jersey and the New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services.
- Lead RRP Certification Program – On August 9, 2010 John Morgan and Mr. Jenney will be attending an 8 hour course to become certified under the EPA's renovation, repair and painting rule in lead safe work practices.
- Energy Savings/Green Products – A list of energy saving, green products and recyclables were given to the committee.

3. Technology Committee

Items Discussed:

- Mr. Frisina introduced a modified check list for supervisors to use to monitor technology usage in the classroom. The supervisor's lesson plan check list includes a column that addresses Core Content Standards for technology.
- Mr. Frisina reviewed the computer prices for the 2010-2011 school year. The quotes were discussed and the committee recommends continuing with Dell computers. The quotes are as follows: Desktops - \$713.00 with 1 year extended warranties; Laptops - \$903.00 with 3 year extended warranties.
- Mr. Frisina addressed the 2010-2011 technology budgets that are included in the 3 year technology plan. Mr. Romano will discuss the figures with Mr. Michaud concerning the 2% "projected" increase in salaries.
- The topic of computer security was discussed. This included the discussion on the security of the computer units and peripheral devices. This topic will be readdressed with principals and their respective building procedures. Mr. Frisina will begin researching the cost of using a LOJACK type system on laptops to assist with unit security.
- Mr. Benedict gave a Web Page update. We, as a committee, are in agreement that the website should remain as the main site. Principals must continue to provide Mr. Benedict with monthly information needed to keep it up-to-date. Additional school sites developed by parents or PTOs should be carefully monitored by the principal.
- Mr. Benedict discussed Genesis and the summer school program developed in the system. Mrs. Anes would like the technology department to possibly change the pressure seal paper due to clarity and position of grade information. Mr. Benedict and Mr. Frisina have been working on the problem and will resolve it by next year.


