#### VII. <u>COMMITTEE REPORTS</u>

#### 1. <u>BUDGET PLANNING AND OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE</u>

September 12, 2022 – 4:00 P.M. to 5:45 P.M.

In attendance: Biral Patel, Brian Rivera, Mohin Patel, Douglas Schneider, Bernard F. Bragen, Jr., Ed.D., Edward Aldarelli, Ed.D., Ann T. Kluck, and William Kolibas and Jen Edwards from Acacia

Business Discussed:

- Facilities Updated and Equipment Purchase
- ESIP ECM's required for District and ESIP Solar PPA
- Presentation from Financial Advisor, Acacia.
- Health, Dental and Prescription Insurance Review

**Recommendations:** 

- The Committee asked to meet with DCO Energy and Acacia Financial for further review of ESIP ECM's and numbers.
- The Committee will again review insurance numbers.
- Facilities Updated and Equipment Purchase Mr. Kolibas discussed purchasing of the equipment and indicated that 145k was allocated in the budget for snow removal. The equipment for snow removal and tree services needs work and is recommended to purchase new equipment. The Committee agreed to the equipment purchase. Mr. Kolibas asked to obtain a Project Manager for all the construction projects, who can be the point person for the same. ESIP ECM's Required for District Mr. Kolibas and Dr. Bragen discussed a priority list for ESIP ECM's. Top items were lighting inside and outside, changes of LED's energy management systems, boilers, rooftop replacements and water consumption equipment. The Committee also discussed if these can be done by the district themselves instead of DCO. The Committee asked the administration to reach out to DCO for the next steps for the ECM's for ESIP, except the Solar PPA.
- ESIP ECM's for Solar PPA The Committee and Dr. Bragen reviewed the option of issuing an RFP for Solar PPA for ESIP. Dr. Bragen will ask ECO to review with the committee the ECM's for ESIP without the Solar PPA and the committee shall review the numbers.
- Presentation from Financial Advisor, Acacia Ms. Edwards provided very useful information and options for borrowing. It was indicated that the reason why the District should go through ESIP is so that they can do a 20 year lease, because savings or the energy project pays for it. Current energy cost for the District is close to \$3 million. ESIP program becomes beneficial for the District as it gives financing options and it is advisable for the District to use financing for the program to take advantage of the savings. The Committee decided to meet with DCO Energy and the Financial Advisor to go over the updated numbers.

The Committee discussed with the Financial Advisor about options for a Lease Purchase for the projects that are in the current Infrastructure Plan. The recommendation was to use capital reserves for some projects and finance for some projects. The Committee decided to meet with the financial advisor again to go over the numbers. There are certain projects that can qualify for financing and certain cannot. For example, the John P. Stevens high School addition would qualify for financing.

• Insurance Review – The Committee reviewed final numbers for the Health, Dental and prescription Insurance for the fiscal year 2022. For the whole year it was \$40.6 million. The District had budgeted \$39.6 million and received approximately \$2 million in prescription rebates, meaning the costs were under the budgeted amount. The District also created an insurance reserve of approximately \$4 million, and committed to \$9 million from excess surplus to add the health reserve account. The final numbers will be determined after the audit for Fiscal Year 2022 is completed. It was revealed by the new insurance broker that about \$43k went to Alamo for commission for prescription, in excess of the agreement regarding Alamo's commission. In addition to this, 10-percent of vision coverage, prescription premiums of those who took vision insurance, was going to Alamo as well.

### 2. <u>TOWNSHIP LIAISON COMMITTEE</u>

• Mrs. White thanked Senator Diegnan for the increased funding and asked if this was a one-time thing. Edison reviewed electric school bus finding and security cameras on and off the buses. Mr. Patel asked about the possibility of live flowers in our county parks as opposed to artificial ones. He reminded everyone of the drought this summer and the artificial flowers worked well. Mr. Patel also asked for additional restrooms in the county parks. The Senator asked for a "Wish List" from the board of education for review. Dr. Bragen will provide one.

• Mr. Taylor provided information on the property covered by Green Acres/Rossi. He will be sending us additional information for review.

• Mr. Diehl gave an update on the Township Master Plan. The Committee has been meeting regularly. This is not an easy task, and they hope to complete it in 12 to 14 months. There is a meeting scheduled for October 19, 2022 at the Municipal Building for the Different town groups to share information.

• Deputy Chief Dudash provided information on the Junior Police Academy. They were well attended and successful and will be continued in the future. Crossing Guards have a shortage and he encouraged any interested to please apply at \$19 an hour. Privatization is still on the table for this matter. He along with Sgt. Cimmino, updated the committee on some of the traffic issues in Edison. At John P. Stevens High School, there is a right turn only and it seems to be working in a positive way. Herbert Hoover Middle School is continuing with the same traffic pattern from last year and it is also working. James Monroe Elementary School has new signage, painted curbs and crosswalks. Parents and guests are still adjusting to the changes in traffic patterns. Woodrow Wilson Middle School will be opening one of the side streets to help with traffic flow before and after school. Deputy Fire Chief Andy Toth provided Mrs. White with information on the Jobs Opportunity film that has been a work in progress. It should be completed by the end of October. Lighted crosswalks and signage for Plainfield Road near Woodrow Wilson Middle School are still in the works.

#### IX. BOARD MEMBERS - OPEN DISCUSSION

Dr. Bragen addressed transportation concerns that the Board of Education Administration and Transportation Department are working on, including (1) outside vendors, (2) bus driver shortage and (3) subscription bussing.

Mrs. Madhukar discussed a Transportation Google Form acknowledgement.

John P. Stevens High School - Ms. Vivian Lee reported that she is one of the Presidents of the Student Council at John P. Stevens High School. She said that although school has just started, it looks like it is going to be an exciting year. A lot has happened since September 6<sup>th</sup>. The choir has been invited to perform at the All Nationals Conference in Cincinnati, Ohio this year. Only 28 choirs across the country are invited to this event and John P. Stevens High School Choir is one of them. They are also the only choir attending from New Jersey, which is a huge honor. One of the football captains, Marcella Iversen, has been nominated for the USA's Football's heart of a Giant. Please support her by voting on usafootball.com/hoagvote. At last Friday's game, September 16<sup>th</sup>, the Class of 2023 hosted a Tailgate. She invited everyone to come out to a football game this year. At the games, the marching band has a new show...the Circle of Life. The next home game is September 30<sup>th</sup>. The boys' Soccer Team has proven to be a tough opponent this year. They won their first game 4 to 1 on September 8<sup>th</sup> against Bayonne High School. It looks like a promising season.

Edison High School – Ms. Sarina Ahmed reported that the Freshman Orientation welcomed over 500 students.
